SR-248 richardson flat road to round valley drive

WHAT'S HAPPENING AND WHEN


UDOT, in partnership with Park City, will be performing road widening and intersection improvements on SR-248. The project will improve the intersection of Richardson Flat Rd and SR-248 with dedicated turn lanes and installation of infrastructure for future traffic signal. The project will also widen SR-248 to five lanes from Richardson Flat to Round Valley Drive with dedicated bike lanes.

Construction begins Monday, June 17th **2013** and is anticipated for completion on August 15th, 2013. Construction hours are Monday through Friday 7:00 am to 6:00 pm (with some Saturdays anticipated).

Construction suspends for the 4th of July weekend (beginning Wednesday, July 3rd at 3:00 pm through Monday, July 8th at 7:00 am) and for Pioneer Day (beginning Tuesday, July 23rd 3:00 pm through Thursday, July 25 6:00 am).

Two-way travel will remain open on SR-248 at all times. Quinn's Junction/Rail Trail Connector (trail underpass at Richardson Flat) will have day-time closures beginning June 17, 2013 through July 8, 2013 (some night-time closures are anticipated) with detour at Richardson Flat intersection near flagger operations during the daytime closure.

Tunnel will reopen each evening (upon UDOT safety inspection) Detour Details

From Park City to Round Valley

At trailhead closure, head north on Richardson Flat Road to SR-248. Cross near flagger operation and reconnect to trail on north side of SR-248 and head east to Round Valley.

From Round Valley to Park City

Use temporary trail detour and cross SR-248 at Richardson Flat Road near flagger operation. Head south on Richardson Flat Road to reconnect to Rail Trail trailhead.
