## RESOLUTION PROCLAMING SEPTEMBER, 2013 AS NATIONAL PREPAREDNESS MONTH IN PARK CITY, UTAH

WHEREAS, the Congress and President of the United States have designated September, 2013 as National Preparedness Month; and

WHEREAS, "National Preparedness Month" creates an important opportunity for every resident of Park City to prepare their families, homes, businesses and community for any type of emergency including natural disasters and human caused emergencies; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council herby proclaim September, 2013 as National Preparedness Month in Park City and encourages all citizens and businesses to develop their own emergency preparedness plan, prepare their own families and businesses and work together toward creating a more prepared society.
