

Procurement Notice – De-Oxygenation of Water for Ice Rink Applications

Park City Municipal Corporation (PCMC) is seeking to purchase equipment that will reduce costs for heating water by removing oxygen by mechanically degassing the water used to resurface and build an artificial ice sheet. The equipment (e.g., degasifying system) should be capable of reducing the dissolved oxygen content below 1 ppm at a water temperature of 80°F or less. PCMC plan to purchase equipment for a system that will provide a minimum flow rate of 50 gallon per minute (gpm) while maintaining the specified purity level. PCMC is requiring a warranty of at least one year and a price that includes costs for installation, support, repair and replacement services.
