Ms. Robinson explained Council's mandate in February. Right now, 5.3% of housing stock is permanently deed-restricted. By 2020 (in five years) Council's goal is to raise this to seven percent which is a total of 184 new units over the next five years. City Council has committed \$40M to achieve this goal.
