



Parking and Traffic Impacts



PLEASE SLOW DOWN AND WATCH FOR CHILDREN IN THE MAIN STREET, OLD TOWN AND RESIDENTIAL AREAS!



TAKE THE BUS

Take the bus, bike or carpool to avoid and help to reduce traffic. Free transit will be provided from Park City Mountain and the high school to the Main Street/Old Town Area.



PARKING

Attendees are encouraged to park for FREE at the base of Park City Mountain. Free parking is also available at Park City High School, but be advised that school will still be in session, which will limit access and availability. Limited parking is also available in the China Bridge Parking Structure with entry from Marsac Avenue only. Patrons may exit China Bridge on Swede Alley but will only be permitted to turn right (north) on Swede Alley.



ROAD CLOSURES

All of Main Street will close to traffic & parking at 2 p.m. Main Street is expected to reopen no later than 7 p.m.

Swede Alley will be one way only, headed north, from 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. during the event.

MAIN STREET HOWL-O-WEEEN SAFETY TIPS

- Know the weather: pack the right gear for rain, snow, or shine—especially for kids.
- Well-behaved, vaccinated dogs on leash welcome.
- Map out day-of logistics beforehand and designate a meeting place for your group.

PARENTS AND GUARDIANS:

- Accompany smaller children into buildings: the crowds can be very disorienting.
- Take a photograph of your child in costume when you first arrive at the event, in case you become separated from him/her.
- A uniformed police officer will be assigned to each block. If you do become separated from your child, find the closest officer and show him/her the photograph of your child in costume.
