The excessive excavation required also break with the natural contour of the slope and attracts the attention on its enormity and ugliness. There should be no such excavation in such a sensitive, pristine and historical area!

Instead - and this is my constructive contribution - the architecture should mimic and expand the look of the existing houses, but gently, naturally and organically "hugging" the hill instead of standing up like an ugly sore thumb.
