Eligibility: This credit application is for a property that has an indirect (usually water flows over driveways or landscaping towards a public street, ditch or creek) connection to Park City's stormwater system, creek, or other waterway. If the property has a direct connection (usually a collection pipe), please complete the large system stormwater credit application.


