



TREASURE HILL COMMUNITY OPTIONS PUBLIC OPEN HOUSES

Park City Municipal Corporation is hosting two **Treasure Hill Community Options Public Open Houses**.

Dates: Tuesday, July 13

City representatives and the Sweeney family are exploring alternatives to the proposed Treasure Hill plan. Five conceptual development options will be on display at the Public Open House. These options represent a wide range of options including density reduction, density transfer, open space acquisition, and other types of on- and off-site development and improvements.

All community members are invited to attend and learn about these options and provide feedback. Park City staff and the Treasure Hill owners will be in attendance to answer questions. Feedback gathered at this meeting will be considered as both sides work to refine the concept plans. These are the first in a series of planned public meetings.

Community members may drop by the Open House at any time between 6pm and 8pm. There is no formal presentation or public hearing.
