About this Report

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey™, the City of Park City conducted a mailed survey of 1,500 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in September 2017 and data were collected through October 18, 2017. After the official data collection period was over (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: Community Livability Report, Park City, UT, 2017*), the City made available a web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's website. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey from November 15, 2017 through December 1, 2017 and 308 surveys were received. Respondents had the option to complete the online survey in English or in Spanish. Of the 308 surveys received, 15 were completed in Spanish and 293 in English.

This report contains the results of this administration of the web-based survey that have not been weighted to current population estimates of Park City.
