### Paid Parking Implementation Background

- In June 2016 Nelson Nygaard was contracted to perform *Downtown and Main Street Parking Management Plan, Executive Summary* (link below) that identified options to better manage the existing area parking supply. The recommendation was to implement demand based paid parking on Main Street, in China Bridge and surrounding surface lots. June [2016 Downtown & Main Street Parking Management Plan](#)
- December 2016 Dixon Resources Unlimited was hired to implement parking management matching the 2016 *Downtown and Main Street Parking Management Plan*. March 2017 T2 was hired to perform technical aspects of Complete Parking Management Solution RFP.
- June 2017 Council approved an evening-only (after 5 p.m.) December 15, 2017 paid parking launch as detailed in the updated Transportation Demand Management Plan June 2017 [Updated Transportation Demand Management Plan](#)
- July 20, 2017 Council approved Fee Schedule, Section 7 for updated public parking fees and citations in the Main Street area. July 20, 2017 [Resolution Amending Section 7 of the Fee Schedule](#) (page 294)
- November 9, 2017 Informational Council Staff Communication detailing two new lot zones November 9, 2017 [Parking Enforcement Zone Updates](#) (page 47). Advertised in Park Record Newspaper on October 21, 2017 & October 25, 2017.
- November 15, 2017 Kenzie Coulson (Parking Services & Fleet Manager) and Blake Fonnesbeck (Director of Transit & Public Works) met with Library Board, discussing potential next steps of lot signage and enforcement. Discussed item at [December 14, 2017 meeting](#) (pg 22).
