









  - **Engineering agreement underway to design and build a large scale renewable electricity facility with construction beginning May 2019.**

- **Received Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting for Fiscal Year 2016 (received in 2017) for the 29th consecutive year;**
- **Completed an overhaul of Title 4 in the Municipal Code for Business Licensing;**
- **Successfully changed the business license renewal date to 10/1 of each year to reduce pressure during Sundance; and**
- **Successfully implemented the new parking system into our revenue streams, cash flow, and reconciliations.**

  - **Added a Mobile Command Trailer (MCT) to our public safety arsenal for use by law enforcement, emergency management and regional partners as needed.**








  - **Hosted US Olympic Committee Media Summit.**



  - **Organized special events to honor our outgoing Mayor and Council member, and to welcome our new Mayor and Council members.**
