Saturday, August 17, 2019 - Stage 5


10:30 – 10:45 Ultimate Challenge race begins at Canyons Village. Canyons Resort Dr. and SR 224 closed for start of race. Rules of the road prevail for the remainder of the race, no further impacts expected.

Expect minor delays (<5 minutes) to 7 Pink at Canyons - Minor delays (<10 minutes) to 6 Lime, 7 Pink, 10 White on SR 224 at Sun Peak Dr.

- 2:30 2:45 Tour of Utah race begins at Canyons Village. Expect minor delays (<5 minutes) to 7 Pink at Canyons
- 2:35 2:45 -- SR 224 closed at Sun Peak Dr. / Old Ranch Rd. Minor delays (<10 minutes) to 6 Lime, 7 Pink, 10 White
- 2:35 2:50 Race passes through Highland Estates via Highland Dr. 8 Brown may experience minor (<5 minutes) to moderate delays (10 15 minutes) depending on timing.
- 4:40 5:15 Race returns to Park City via SR 248, road closed in both directions inbound/outbound 11 Black from Kamas may encounter road closure depending on race progress. If necessary, reroute inbound to Jordanelle Pkwy and Richardson Flat Rd.
- 5:00 5:45pm Race passes through Newpark/Redstone via Highland Dr. and Newpark Blvd. SR 224, Newpark Blvd., Highland Dr., and Olympic Pkwy closed to all traffic.

The OTTC charger is down, meaning short range electrics should not be put on this route, or will likely need to be traded out during the road closure.

5:00 – 6:15 – Race returns to Canyons Village. Canyons Resort Dr. closed from Frostwood up to Canyons Village. 7 Pink will have to bypass Grand Summit until road closure ends.



TOUR OF UTAH SUNDAY, AUGUST 18, 2019

Main Street closed all day, no AM Trolley service, no AM operator assigned to 1710. PM Trolley operator to cover Kamas Commuter portion of 1710 block.

Heber Ave. closed all day. Routes covering Park Ave will use 9th Street inbound and outbound except during road closures.

Yellow route reinstated 10:00am - 6:00pm. 2 buses, 10 minute frequency, no Deer Valley or Park Avenue portions of loop. Block 630 shift extended, operator to provide lunch relief for 510 and 520 blocks.

12:30 – 12:55 -- Race begins with 2 neutral laps on Main St/Swede Alley/Deer Valley Dr., then proceeds down Deer Valley Dr. to Bonanza Dr., to Kearns Blvd and east on SR 248 to Kamas.

All routes hold in place at point of closure. Resume routing once road reopened. Utilize tripper units to restore on time performance as necessary.

- 3:00 5:00 Race returns to Main Street for finish via Marsac Ave/Deer Valley Drive. Marsac, Deer Valley, Swede, 9th, and OTTC shut down until race finish, limited or no access to old town.
 - 1 Red, 2 Green, 6 Lime routes will bypass OTTC and head outbound from PCMR during closure. M Hewitt will be on site to assist.
 - 10 White routes will make a left turn onto Iron Horse after departing Park Ave Condos, right onto Shortline, Right onto Deer Valley, and right onto Park Ave to resume outbound routing at Fresh Market. 1 express unit to be held at OTTC until outload.
 - 5 Yellow routes will turn right onto Iron Horse from Bonanza and proceed to Fresh Market heading outbound. Transfer passengers for PCMR and old town to Park Ave Condos.
 - Stage 4 tripper units at OTTC prior to closure for loadout. 1 each for Red, Green, Yellow, and Deer Valley.

Monitor passenger loads at resort and school district parking lots, add tripper units for capacity as needed.

2 Park Ave trippers in place prior to closure, assigned to cutaway buses. Route runs from PCMR, up Park Ave, right turn on 10th Street, left turn onto Woodside, left turn onto 8th Street, left turn onto Park Ave.
