The Main Street Post Office holds standard hours during the Festival, although it is best to pick up your mail before 1:00 p.m. 30-minute parking spaces are available along 5th Street.

Park City Transit on Demand

Passengers can request a ride from Transit on Demand by dialing 435.640.7819. A Park City Transit vehicle will arrive no more than 15 minutes after specified pick-up time.

**To guarantee pickup within 15 minutes of requested time, request your ride at least one hour in advance.*

PARKING

Public parking in the Old Town area will be by permit or pay only January 23-February 1, 2020. Main Street patrons and employees are encouraged to ride the bus to avoid parking challenges and congestion. During the Festival, the last bus leaves the Main Street Transit Center at 2:25 a.m.

*If driving, please Turn your Key and Be Idle Free!
Do not cut through residential neighborhoods.*

Parking Closures

During the following dates, parking will be removed at the following locations:

- **January 16-February 4:** Bob Wells Plaza Parking Lot
- **January 21-22:** West Side of Main Street
- **January 22:** Park Avenue (from Heber Avenue to 9th Street)
- **January 22-February 1:** North Marsac Parking Lot
- **January 23-February 1:** all of Main Street and Heber Avenue, Brew Pub Parking Lot, East Side of Park Avenue, West Side of Park Avenue (resident parking only), and Swede Alley Surface Lots
- **January 30:** Flagpole Parking Lot



FREE PARKING

Richardson Flat Park-and-Ride

Free parking with free transit to and from Prospector/Old Town, from 7:00 a.m.-2:25 a.m. January 23-February 1. Take the bus from this lot to Prospector, where you can transfer to the Old Town Transit Center, event venues, and theatres throughout Park City.

Homestake Lot (1875 Homestake Road)

Available to Main Street employees, with proper vehicle registration. Free transit to/from the lot is available from 8:00 a.m.-3:00 a.m. throughout the Festival, with an on-call guaranteed ride home after 3:00 a.m. To register:

Resort Parking Lots

Deer Valley Resort and Park City Mountain have partnered with the City to allow use of their parking lots outside of resort hours during the Festival.

- Resort lots are available for parking 4:00 p.m.-2:00 a.m. daily, January 23-February 1.
- Free Park City Transit connects both resorts to the Old Town Transit Center, from where you can walk or transfer buses.
- Please mind all posted signs and regulations in these lots. Vehicles left in the resort lots after 2:00 a.m. will be towed at the owner's expense.

Ecker Hill Park-and-Ride (2465 Kilby Road)

Free transit system runs from the Ecker Hill Park-and-Ride approximately every 15 minutes during peak hours.

Sandridge Lots

Free parking access via Marsac Avenue.

Note: these lots will fill early each morning.

PERMITTED PARKING

“Special Use of Load In/Load Out” Permits

Commercial permits are required to load in/out of a Main Street venues, for crowd control, satellite truck parking, POD storage, use of a lift/boom, or if using public parking spaces for an activity.

Call 435.615.5301 to obtain a “Special Use of Load In/Load Out” Permit. Permit deadline is 72 hours prior to any instance noted above. Visit parkcity.org/departments/parking.

Parking Permit Holders

During the Festival, Blue Permit and Carpool Permit holders may park in the Flagpole Lot, Sandridge Lots, or in the Gateway Center upper level lot, accessed from Heber Avenue.

A permit guaranteeing a spot in the China Bridge garage is available for \$550 and is valid from January 23-February 2. Entry for guaranteed parking is from Swede Alley. This permit is available from parkcity.org/departments/parking or by calling 435.615.5301.





PAID PARKING

China Bridge Parking Structure

**Entry from Marsac Avenue only. No in and out privileges. Cash preferred.*

- **January 23:** \$40
- **January 24-25:** \$60
- **January 26-27:** \$40
- **January 28-30:** \$3/hour after 5:00 p.m. (first hour free, max \$18)
- **January 31-February 1:** \$30

Flagpole Parking Lot

January 23-February 1: Blue and Carpool permit parking only.

Private Paid Parking

There are various private parking garages throughout Old Town. Private parking lots have their own payment structures and regulations — costs vary \$20-100+ per day.

ADA Parking

ADA spaces are available behind the Park City History Museum on Swede Alley. Additional ADA spaces are available in the Brew Pub Parking Lot. All City parking lots that are open to the public will continue to offer ADA spaces.

A few suggestions:

- If possible, alter your schedule to avoid commuting during peak time periods.
- Plan ahead and factor in extra time for travel.
- Ride the bus, walk, or carpool. Visit parkcitytransit.org to plan your trip.
- Practice patience – winter weather conditions can intensify traffic congestion.

TEMPORARY ONE-WAY STREETS

In order to reduce residential traffic, increase transit priority and ensure public safety, the following streets will be one-way during the Festival:

- Park Avenue – one-way north (out of town)
- Hillside Avenue – one-way west (into town)
- 4th and 5th Streets from Park Avenue to Main Street – one-way east (into commercial district)

*Access passes for these areas will be distributed January 17. If additional passes are needed, visit the City Hall Front Desk, Monday-Friday, 8:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Questions? Call Jenny Diersen, at 435.640.5063 or jenny.diersen@parkcity.org.

All other vehicles must follow posted signs and traffic direction, unless access pass is received.

DROP & LOAD, TAXIS, RIDESHARE, SHUTTLES

To use drop and load areas, drivers must remain in the vehicle, pull to curb as to not block traffic, and actively drop and load passengers. Double parked vehicles will be ticketed. Drop and Load areas are also available at the following locations:

Lyft Pick Up & Drop Off Zones (must display Lyft decal):

- 9th Street Turnaround
- Swede Alley behind Park City Museum
- Brew Pub Parking Lot (Thursday, January 23-Monday, January 27)

General Drop & Load Areas (Taxi, Hotel Shuttles, General Public):

- Brew Pub Parking Lot
- South Marsac Lot – Thursday, January 23-Sunday, January 26 and Saturday, February 1-Sunday, February 2

RESIDENTIAL AREAS

Whether you are visiting, providing transportation services, heading to work, or picking up a friend, please do not cut through residential areas. During the Festival, additional security will be in place to deter cut-through traffic in residential areas.

WINTER STREETS MAINTENANCE

Park City completes winter maintenance for all public parking lots and streets between 2:00-6:00 a.m. daily. Overnight parking is not permitted. Cars left in public lots or on streets are subject to ticketing or towing at the owner's expense.
