

Park City Transit Update

Effective April 19, 2020



REDUCED TRANSIT SERVICE

Effective **SUNDAY, APRIL 19, 2020**, Park City Transit is reducing service frequency and hours of operation on some routes and suspending service on others.

- 1 Red**— Service Suspended and replaced with ● City-Wide and ● On-Demand service.
- 2 Green**— Service Suspended and replaced with ● City-Wide route.
- 6 Lime**— Service ends at 9:51 PM from PC Mountain. No service to Main St./Deer Valley.
- 7 Pink**— Service ends at 9:45 PM from Grand Summit.
- 8 Brown**— Service ends at 10:00 PM from Kimball Junction Transit Center (KJTC).
- 9 Purple**—Service remains suspended until further notice.
- 10 White**— Service ends 9:40 PM from Main St. 30-minute frequency all hours.
- 11 Black**— First trip to Kamas (5:42 AM) and first trip to Park City (6:17 AM) both eliminated.
- City-Wide**— Service from 6:14 AM-10:14 PM from Main St. 30-minute frequency all hours.
- On-Demand**— Service to select stops from 7:00 AM-9:00 PM and any stop systemwide 9:00 PM-12:00 AM.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

We are asking our riders to continue practicing social distancing and good hygiene habits. Together, we can help keep each other healthy and slow the spread of COVID-19.

1. Stay home if you're ill. Even if you're well, avoid all non-essential trips and use other modes, such as walking or biking, if possible.
2. If you do need to ride Park City Transit, please exit and board through the rear doors to protect our drivers. An exception is made for riders who need the boarding ramp at the front door.
3. Leave at least one empty seat between you and other riders at all times.
4. If the bus is too full to leave adequate distance between riders, please wait for the next bus. No standing passengers, please!
