Shipping will Commence about/or near January 3, 2020 or hold for pickup at our Will Call, Park City Public Works at 1053 Iron Horse Drive, Park City, Utah (between the hours of 8Am to 5PM Monday to Friday) (Closed for Martin Luther King holiday on Monday) .**
- **Cost of permit is \$550, NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED FOR PURCHASED PERMITS.**
- **NO REPLACEMENTS WILL BE ISSUED FOR LOST/STOLEN PERMITS.**
