This letter is a follow up on discussions regarding alternative disposal options for Bevil Exempt mine wastes in the Park City area. Bevil exempt mine waste may be disposed of in a Subtitle D landfill meeting the applicable requirements of R315-301 through R315-320. All waste material to be disposed of in the Subtitle D landfill shall be characterized to ensure the waste meets the criteria for the Bevil exemption prior to disposal. In addition, the permit application for a Subtitle D Landfill shall specify the standards and criteria for acceptance and disposal of all waste material.
