

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Replaster and Retiling of MARC Pools and Hot Tub Project** will be received by Tate Shaw, Assistant Recreation Director, Park City Municipal Corporation (“PCMC”), Park City Recreation Offices, Park City MARC, 1200 Little Kate Rd., Park City, Utah 84060, by **3:00 PM local time, October 4, 2022**, and at 3:05 PM that same day and place will be publicly opened and read aloud. The Replaster and Retiling of MARC Pools project is located at 1200 Little Kate Rd., Park City, Utah 84060. The Replaster and Retiling of MARC Pools project briefly consists of the replaster and retiling of the Lap Pool (4,025 sf), Leisure Pool (2,774 sf), and Hot Tub (275 sf). The work will also require cutting back tile lines, crack sealing, tile replacement, coping stone replacement, joint sealing, epoxy, patchwork with Brown Coat, waterproofing and other related items. A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at the Park City MARC at 1200 Little Kate Rd., Park City, Utah 84060, at 1:00 PM September 27, 2022. Bidders should familiarize themselves with the project site and conditions.
