Miners Day Parade

Monday, September 4, 2023

The annual Miners Day parade returns Monday, September 4 at 11:00 a.m., following the annual Running of the Balls down Main Street at 10:45 a.m. The parade route includes Main Street and Park Avenue, and concludes at City Park.

PARKING AND ROAD CLOSURES

- **6:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m.** Vehicles and parking will be removed from Main Street, Swede Alley, Swede Alley Surface Lots, Heber Avenue, and Park Avenue (9th Street to 14th Street) on Monday, September 4. Traffic will be restricted throughout the event. No parking for event activities at the South End of City Park, the Library, or on Sullivan Road.

FREE PARKING AND TRANSIT

- **Richardson Flat Park-and-Ride:** free parking with free transit (10-minute frequency).
- **Park City School District (Kearns Blvd.):** free parking with free transit to/from Old Town.
- **Park City Mountain and Deer Valley Resorts:** free parking with free transit to/from Old Town.

Increased Transit routes with a bus lane on Deer Valley Drive. Check parkcitytransit.org or highvalleytransit.org for full schedules.

PAID PARKING

China Bridge Parking Structure:

- \$15/day 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. Standard rates after 1:00 p.m.

Main Street and Swede Alley Surface Parking Lots:

- Standard rates after 1:00 p.m.

Private Parking Lots:

- Available throughout Old Town, with varying regulations, pay structures, and costs.

PARKING PERMIT HOLDERS

- **Business, Carpool, and Employee Permits:** pass holders can park in the North Marsac (access via Marsac Avenue) or the Gateway Center upper lots (access via Heber Avenue). Parking may be available in China Bridge if North Marsac and Gateway are full. *The Flag Pole lot is unavailable 6:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m.*

TAXI STAGING DROP-AND-LOAD

- Drop-and-load and taxi staging area will be available in the South Marsac Lot.

No public parking on Park Avenue or Swede Alley or other residential streets around old town. Access Passes required for residents and businesses with off-street parking. Contact Jenny Diersen (info below) to obtain a pass.
