POLICE COMPLAINT REVIEW COMMITTEE

The Police Complaint Review Committee consists of five (5) members, three (3) citizens from the community at large, and two (2) City staff members consisting of the City Manager's designee and a member of the Management Team. An attorney from the City's Legal staff acts as a legal liaison to the Committee. The Chief of Police acts as an ex officio member of the committee supplying support and information to the Committee.

The three (3) citizen members of the Committee will serve a three (3) year term of office as a volunteer without pay or compensation.

The Committee will meet at 5:00 P.M. on the 3rd Tuesday of each quarter, as needed.

The purpose of the Park City Police Complaint Review Committee is to act in the capacity of an appeals body which will review dispositions of complaints filed against police personnel, if formally requested by the complainant. The Committee will provide advisory recommendation(s) to the Chief of Police on those complaint dispositions reviewed.
